after DS's Sonata for Viola and Piano (2002)



Imperfect tuning  
With a loose bow  
Concentrate on the feel of fingers and the bow  
Unintentional timbre changes may arise at every moment  
Play precariously like a candle flame in the wind  
Hear the sounds not as a melody but as separate colors  
spreading in the acoustic space and fading variously  
Play fragments in sight without premeditated order  
the same fragment may be played a few times  
provided that the second time is not a mere repetition but the renewal  
Duration of notes are short or long without regularity  
dependent on the action required to execute  
the indicated pitch-timbre combinations  
Pages are distributed in any order at several musicstands  
each set apart from the others  
and the performer plays wandering among them on stage

Could be performed simultaneously with  
Piano 4 (An Automat in Suginami Ward)



♯ half (i.e. incompletely) sharp \_\_\_\_\_ (not 1/4 tone)  
♭ half flat \_\_\_\_\_ ambiguous pitch  
● imprecisely around \_\_\_\_\_ out of tune  
(sharp or flat)

→ ← overslide  
→ ← underslide

roll the bow tilt the bow alternatively  
↖↖↖↖↖↖↖↖ toward the fingerboard or the bridge
