
EXERCISE 20 (Snare Drum Peace March)



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Play using fingers (singly or several at once), of right hand for notes with stems going up; left for those going down.

Play

- (1) the first four lines, ignoring broken-lined ties between notes;
- (2) repeat first four lines, observing the ties; then play
- (3) the upper part of remaining systems;
- (4) repeat upper part, using right hand only (including notes with stems going down), together with the lower part, for which use left hand.

Optional additional:

- (5) after playing (4), play the last four systems again, using sticks for the top part and whistling the bottom part; or: after playing
- (1) (1) through (4) as above, play (1) through (5) or a selection from (1) through (5), using sticks (and whistling in (5)).

Snares on/off ad lib. (changing, for instance, as possible during rests). Dynamics, possible amplification (light) ad lib.
